Segment 2 - Walnut Gate to Ft. Worden **Archie, W7ACT** **Jean, W7JLT** At the Ft. Worden Walnut Gate

Make sure Walnut and Admiralty Gates are open. Monitor that no racers cheat by turning toward the fairgrounds without going to the sand first. At direction of race officials, set sign for all racers that are still coming down the hill to go directly to the fairgrounds without going to the sand course first. Keep track and report all racers that were told to bypass the sand course.

Monitor activity at the sand course and report any racers who cheat by not going around the loop at the lighthouse. Check in with Race Officials and communicate any information from them back to Race Central.

Finish time for each racer will be when they cross the finish line.

We will use the Port Townsend Repeater on 145.15 MHz, 114.8 PL and a minus offset. If it fails, we will use 145.15 on simplex with a 114.8 PL.**
